
REIGN OF TERROR

- Robespierre was made the leader of the Committee of Public Safety.
- They enforced the laws created by the National Convention.
- The rights of the people were suspended to keep the National Convention in power.
 - Robespierre became a dictator that could do whatever he wanted.





REIGN OF TERROR


- The Committee executed any enemy of France.
- An estimated 40,000 people were executed during the Reign of Terror
 - Marie Antoinette
 - Georges Danton
 - Robespierre himself...







THE DIRECTORY



- The people of France feared any more radical ideas and went to a moderate government; the Directory.
- Made up of five men.
 - All very corrupt.

Named Napoleon Bonaparte commander of

France's army.







THE FRENCH REVOLUTION... UP TO THE DEATH OF LOUIS XVI

Louis XVI asks the Second Estate for taxes.

Second Estate calls for the Estates-General to legalize the taxation. Third Estate created the National Assembly and calls for more rights.

Tennis Court Oath made by the National Assembly Storming of the Bastille and the Great Fear.

Creation of a constitutional monarchy with Louis XVI and the National Assembly

Louis XVI tries to escape, is caught. Prussia invades and the Legislative Assembly is created; a limited monarchy

Because of fear and pressure from radicals, the National Convention is created. Very radical republic.

Louis XVI is tried for treason, found guilty, and executed.

THE FRENCH REVOLUTION... AFTER THE DEATH OF LOUIS XVI

Jacobins take control and create the Committee for Public Safety under Robespierre.

Anyone suspected of plotting against France was killed.

Robespierre himself was declared too radical and then killed.

The Directory was created as a moderate government.

The Directory was very corrupt, but not radical and hoped to solve some of France's problems.

The Directory appoints Napoleon Bonaparte as commander of France's armies.
